Endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) has been considered first-line treatment for EGC cases that meet the following criteria: well or moderately differentiated tubular or papillary adenocarcinoma with tumor size  $\leq 2$  cm, tumor confined to the mucosal layer, and the absence of ulceration in the tumor.
